CRITERION I – CURRICULAR ASPECTS

Feedback System

The feedback form of our college is collected from stakeholders such as students, Staff, Parents and Alumni.

Student Feedback Form Comprises with;

A. Course Content

The feedback on the part of Course content includes syllabus weight age; subject background; time span in coverage of syllabus; link of subject with overall curriculum; comparison of content with autonomous colleges are included. This support to check whether the course content is framed according to the needs of the student's career.

B. Teaching Learning Process

Teaching process is fulfilled when the students learn. Teachers encourage student's participation and discussion with interaction inside the classroom. Teachers explain the concept and check whether it is understood by students. The portions are gradually covered without overloading with hours. The counselling is given to the students on academic matters. Disagreements in teaching and learning process are valued.

C. Teacher Competencies

The teachers in our college are well experienced with depth subject knowledge which helps the students to grasp better. The students are inspired by the deliverance of lecture. The components such as syllabus completion, usage of ICT tools, and theoretical concepts related to real-life situations are cross checked.

D. Evaluation Process

Periodical assessment is held as per schedule. The internal assessment is unbiased; question paper of the semester is as per syllabus and pattern; results are released in the university portal; and if any grievances are found in the examination it is redressed through well-laid mechanism.

The student's feedback is collected with the above four parameters optioned as a) Always Agree b) Agree c) Neutral d) Disagree e) Strongly Disagree and it is analysed. The feedback is collected with Name of the student, Class, Semester, mobile number and mail id.

The Teachers feedback on curriculum is received with 14 questions covering

- Syllabus content and its suitability to course
- Aim and objectives of the syllabus clearly defined
- Syllabus increase knowledge and perspective of subject area with soft and technical skills
- Books prescribed as reference are appropriate
- Syllabus supports students to develop personality, ethical, moral standards, social responsibility and sense of environmental conscious
- Syllabus content bridge the gap between the expectation of recruiters/ employers and course content; sufficient to get employment in the present job market

The feedback is collected from teachers with Name, Designation of the teacher and department with scales such as Strongly Agree; Agree; Neutral; Disagree and Strongly Disagree.

Alumni Feedback on Curriculum

The feedback on Curriculum is collected from Alumni for every year with details such as Name of the Alumni with full address, Program Studied, Year of Graduation and Present Position. Questions asked from the Alumni include;

1. **Course Content** focusing on syllabus balance between theory & practical; enrich knowledge; develop employability, personality, social responsibility skills and help to develop sense of balanced environment.
2. **Communication Skills** focusing on oral, written and presentation ability.

3. **Leadership skills** enabled with management, problem-solving, emotional intelligence and innovative/smart practices.
4. **Interpersonal Skills** imparting humanity, team work and adaptability.

The alumni feedback in curriculum is collected and analysed with the above four aspects and measured with 5 point scale as Strongly Agree; Agree; Neutral; Disagree and Strongly Disagree.
