2.7 - Student Satisfaction Survey

2.7.1 - Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance (Institution may design its own questionnaire)

The student's strength for the academic year 2022-2023 is 2171. Students Satisfaction Survey was collected from 1,800 UG and PG students of 28 Departments. Responses received include 539 students (30%) from I UG & PG students; 620 students (34%) from II UG & PG students and 641 students (36%) from III UG & PG students.

The feedback was collected with questions such as;

- 48.6% of the students have responded that Syllabus is Covered in the class between 85 to 100%.
- Higher 55.3 % of the students have opinion as Teachers Preparedness for Classes was satisfactory
- 63.9% of the students have given their opinion that the teacher's communication is always effective.
- 46.1% has responded that the teachers approach on teaching is excellent
- Highest 51.5% of the students have responded that Teachers Internal Evaluation Process is always fair.
- 54.1% of the students feel happy that the teachers discuss about their performance in assignment and appreciation makes them to do well in mere future.
- A highest 54.3% of students responded that they get regular support from the college in completion of Students Internship, Exchange and Field Visits as per their syllabus.
- 46.4% of our students have responded that the mentoring process in our college is very well performed and brings Cognitive, Social and Emotional growth between the students.

- Almost 42.7% of the respondents strongly agree that the college bring out multiple opportunities to learn and grow inside the campus.
- 52.4% of the respondents feel that the information on Expected Competencies, Course and Programme Outcomes are explained every time to them.
- 55.9% feel that the mentor follow-up on assigned task every time.
- 52.2% responded that almost all the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.
- 54% of the students have responded that the teachers identify the strength of the students and support them to face positive challenges.
- 51.5% of the students have said that student's weakness was identified every time and help the students to overcome them.
- 45.4% of the students strongly agree that our Institution makes efforts to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process.
- 52.4% strongly agree that Students Centric Methods – Experiential Learning, Participative Learning and Problem-Solving methodologies for enhancing learning skills.
- 49.4% strongly agree that the teachers encourage for student's participation in extra-curricular activities.
- 52.1% of our students responded that great efforts have been taken by Teachers on Capability enhancement on soft skills, life skills and employability to make students to face the competitive world.
- About 43% of the students responded that nearly 70 to 89% of our faculty use ICT Tools while teaching.
- 46.3% strongly agree that the Feedback on overall teaching learning process of our college is very good.

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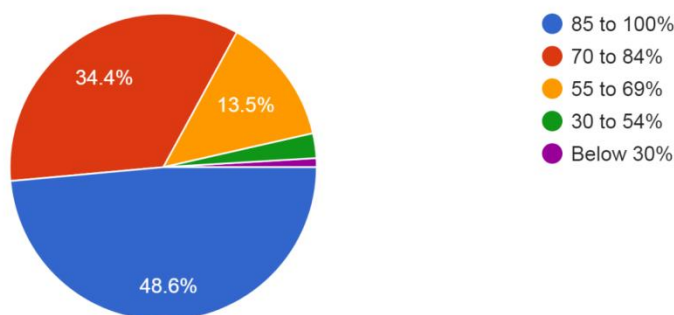

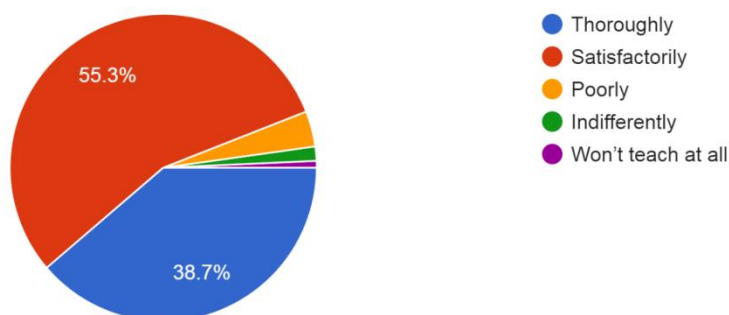
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

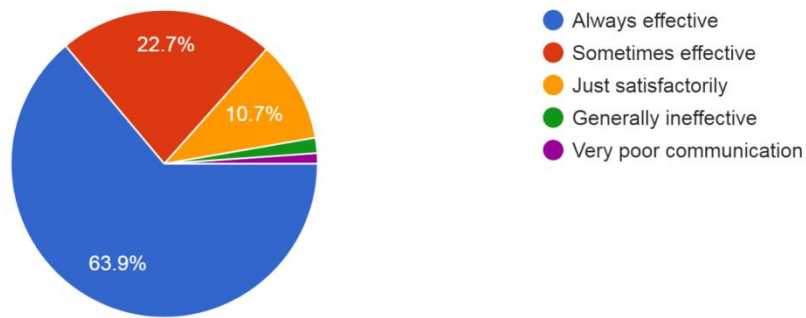
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

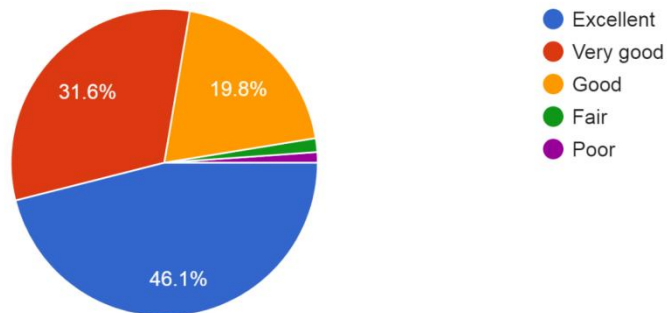
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

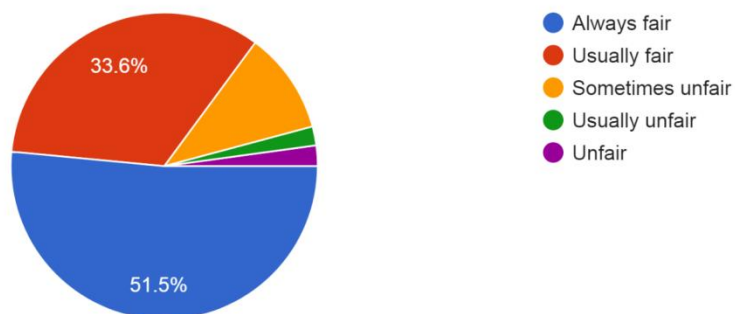
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

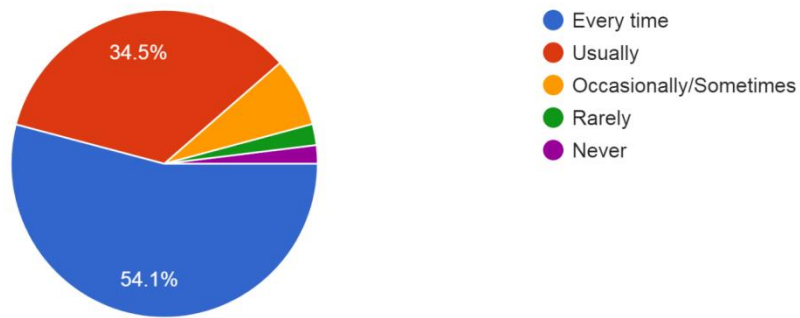
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

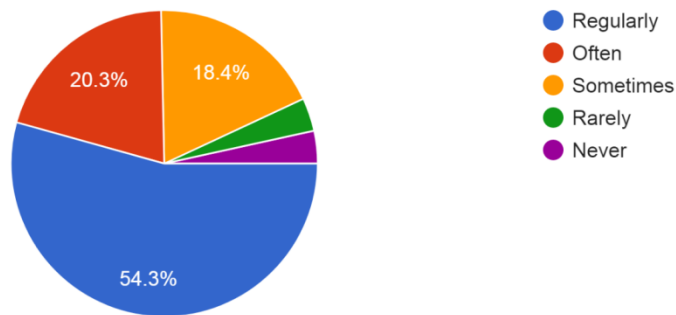
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

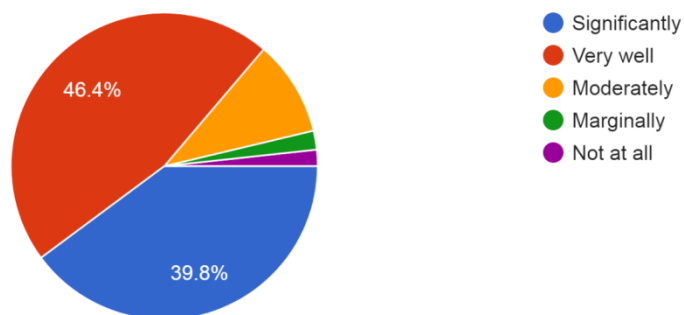

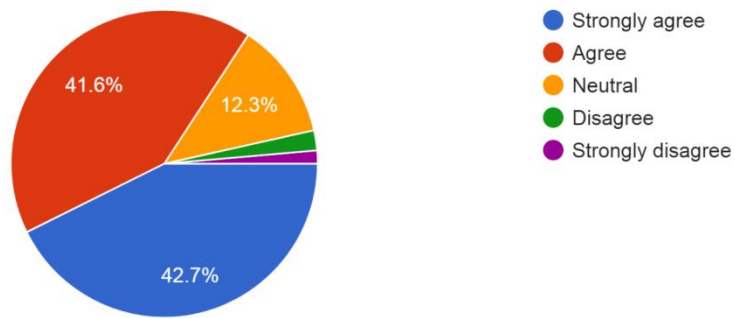
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

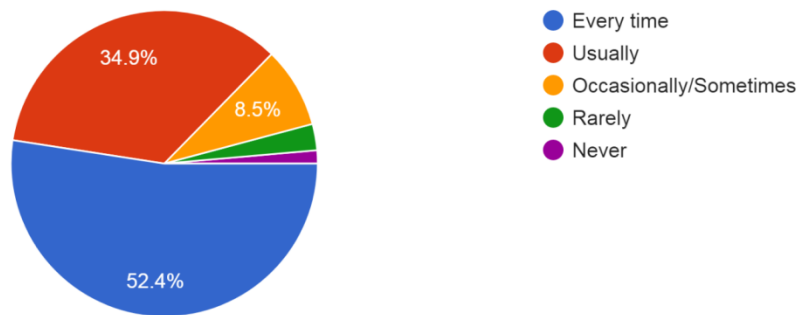

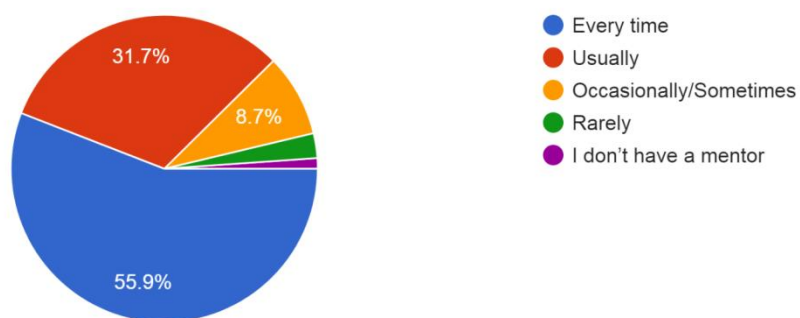

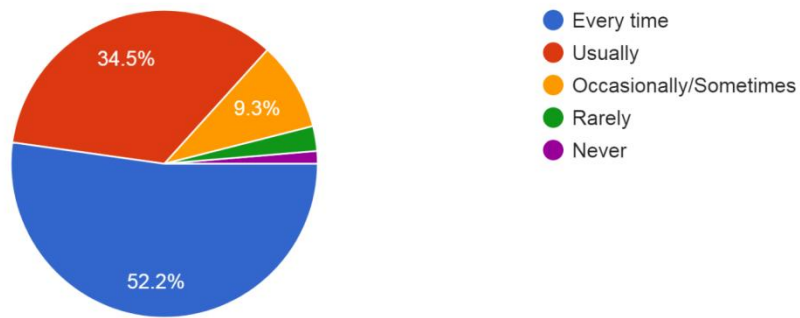

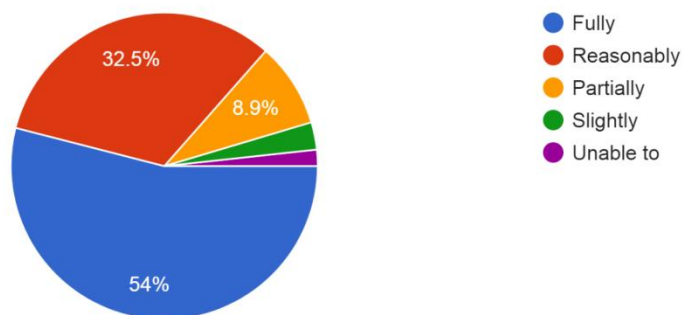

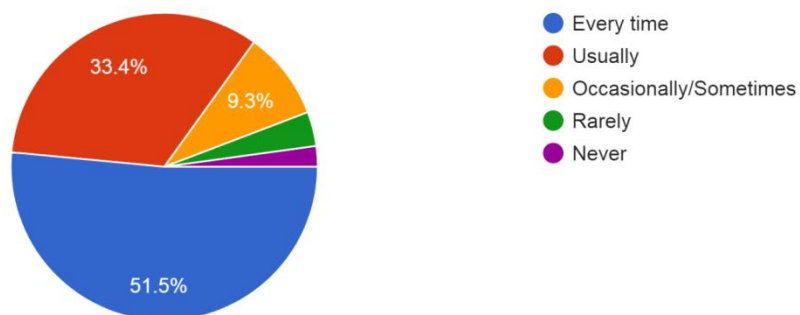

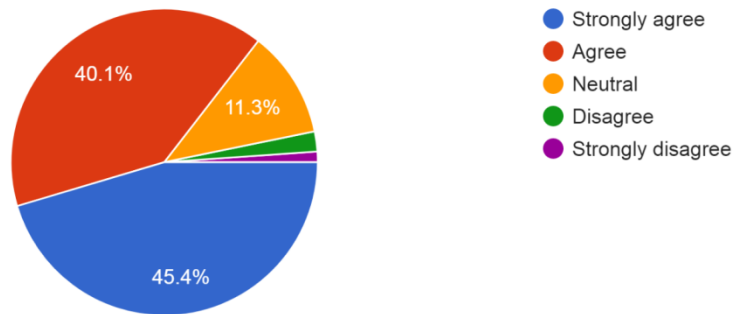

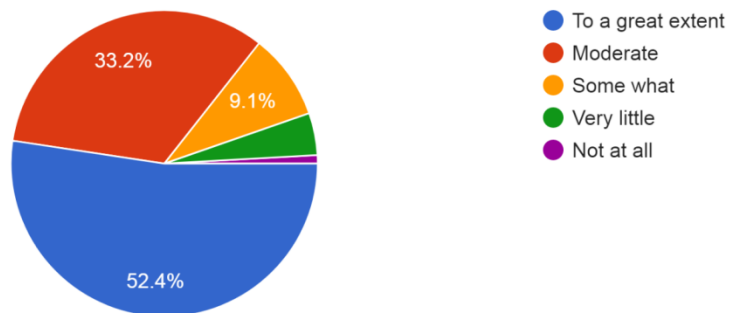

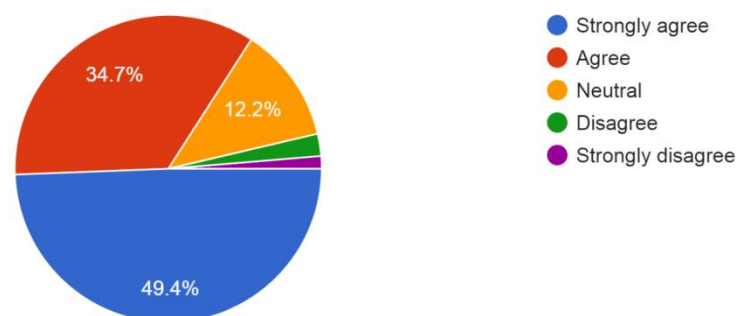

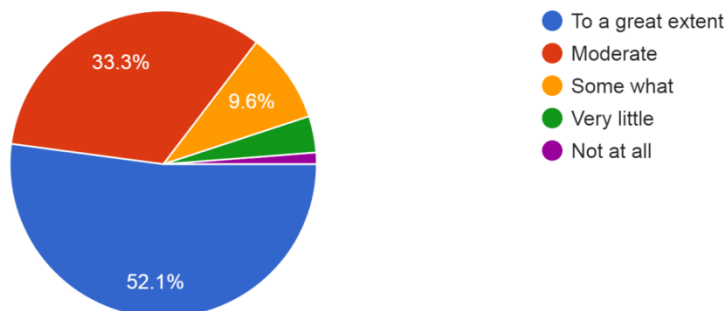

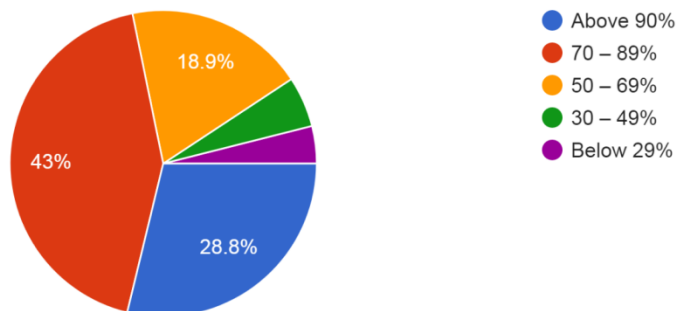
18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ ability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

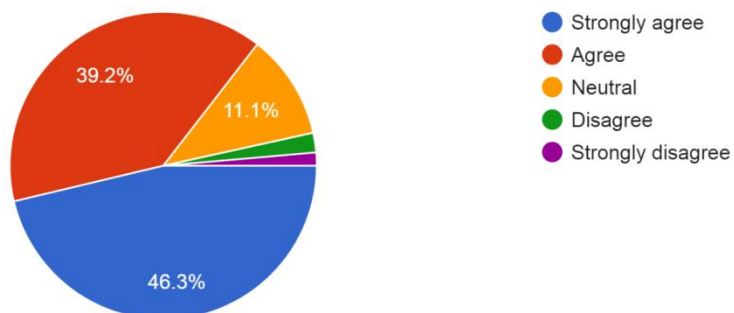
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
