9.1. Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents copy rights and designs) of the other party.

CLAUSE 10 VALIDITY OF THE MOU

10.1 This MoU is valid for a period of Two years (2 Years) with effect from date of signing of this MoU and can be renewed by Mutual consent thereafter. Once agreed, the MoU Shall be in force for a minimum period of one year.

CLAUSE 11

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

11.1 It is expressly agreed that PIE-CHER INFOTECH and Sri Vasavi College are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other party, without the prior written consent of the other party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit. or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 12 BINDING NATURE OF THE MOU

12.1 The MOU is intended to provide a legally non-binding procedural framework to enable the Parties to work together cooperatively toward achieving the goals set forth at the outset of the MOU. Any apparently mandatory language herein such as "Shall" or "will" is intended to merely express the Parties' non-binding intentions hereunder and is not

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, no obligation, covenant, or agreement relating to this MOU shall be binding on the parties, other than the obligations specified in Clauses 8 and 9 above.

CLAUSE 13 GENERAL

- 13.1 Each of the Parties hereto undertake with the other to act in the utmost good faith in interpreting and implementing this MOU and agrees to do all things reasonably within its power which are necessary or desirable to give effect to the spirit and intent of this MOU.
- 13.2 This MOU is the first documented agreement between the Parties; in case of contradictions between it and future agreements, the later one is binding.
- 13.3 Either Party may terminate this MOU upon providing seven days written notice to the other Party, in any case the existing batches should not be left, and PIE-CHER INFOTECH will complete the course as per the schedule and formalities.
- 13.4 This MOU may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same document.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

CSC Computer Education, Bhavani-638301 and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS:

- B) Sri Vasavi College is an Educational Institutions:
 - (i) Affiliated to Bharathiar University, Coimbatore
 - (ii) Engaged in provision of Various Educational Courses and Programmes.
 - (iii) Sri Vasavi College & CSC Computer Education believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities. - a. Organizing trainings to its students in TallyERP9 software in association with CSC Computer education on chargeable basis.
- Obtaining all internal approvals, consents, Permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for the offering of the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- c. Providing necessary infrastructure to conduct the programs offered by CSC Computer Education

CLAUSE 4

OBLIGATIONS OF CSC COMPUTER EDUCATION

- 4.1 CSC Computer Education Shall be responsible for the following
- a. Curriculum design Developing courses/ Workshops
- Providing necessary technical expertise for the programmes Deputing their trainers in Sri Vasavi College campus for the execution of its courses/workshops.
- c. Providing placement Assistance to successful students,

CLAUSE 5

JOINT OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

- 5.1 The Parties agree to obtain all consents, approvals and permission required for giving effect to this MOU.
- 5.2 The Parties subject to mutually agreed assessment regulations shall carry out the Assessment of students on the Programmes. The Parties shall issue transcripts and other certificates jointly.

CLAUSE 6

FINANCIAL TERMS

- 6.1 The Parties would by mutual agreement decide the fees to be collected from each Student enrolled in the programme.
- 6.2 Financial Terms (1st Year): For a minimum of 100 students

6.3 Payment Terms: 50 % at the time of commencement of the training & 50% balance after completion of training and assessment and before issue of course certificate.

CLAUSE 7

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 7.1 In the event of any disputes under this MOU, authorized representatives of CSC Computer Education and Sri Vasavi College shall meet not later than seven (7) working days after receipt of notice by either Party of request for dispute resolution and shall enter into good faith negotiations aimed at resolving the dispute
- 7.2 If the representatives are unable to reach mutually satisfactory, resolution of the dispute within the next fifteen(15) working days, each Party shall, within seven(7), working days, designate a top management executive who will attempt, over the next fifteen(15) days, to resolve the dispute.
- 7.3 It is agreed by both the parties that any difference or dispute in this connection shall be referred to sole Arbitrator to be nominated by both the parties under the Provisions of Arbitration and conciliation Proceedings Act, 1996 and the Award so given by the Arbitrator will be wholly binding on both the Parties and shall not be questioned under any circumstances.

7.4 It is also agreed by both the parties that the Courts Bhavani alone will have the Jurisdiction.

CLAUSE 8

CONFIDENTIALITY

8.1 All Materials and information provided to a party by the other party or acquired by a party on behalf of the other party, whether oral, written, recorded magnetic media, cards, or otherwise, shall be regarded as confidential information in accordance with the applicable laws, ethical standards. Each Party shall take all necessary steps to safeguard the confidentiality of such materials or information. Neither Party shall use the confidential information of the other party for purposes other than those contemplated hereunder.
